FOCUS: Increase an awareness and begin to foster an understanding of how people in South Sudan who are living in poverty receive little income regardless of time and effort.

INSTRUCTIONS: Create your very own South Sudanese Necklace/Bracelet

Design a South Sudanese patterned necklace using a variety of bead colours. Once you have planned out your design, thread the beads onto your string/wool to create your own individual piece of jewellery.

How many necklaces do you think you can make in ½ hour, 1 hour, half a day or even an entire day?

Fasteners / closures (optional)


ADAPTATION:
