



FOCUS: Experience staying in a makeshift shelter like those in refugee camps.

Over **4 million** people in South Sudan have been forced to leave their homes.

85% of these people are children and women.

As a result ... over **200,000** families are living in refugee camps.

AND another **2 million** have fled South Sudan to neighbouring countries.

INSTRUCTIONS:

Have a go a building a shelter and spend time living in it. You may even want to stay overnight. Don't let the weather stop you!

Consider the building materials you may use – tarpaulins, branches, ropes etc. Think of what the people in South Sudan have access to? Keep It Simple.

Think about the size of your shelter, remembering in South Sudan they don't have a lot of room in their homes and their homes are often very close together.
